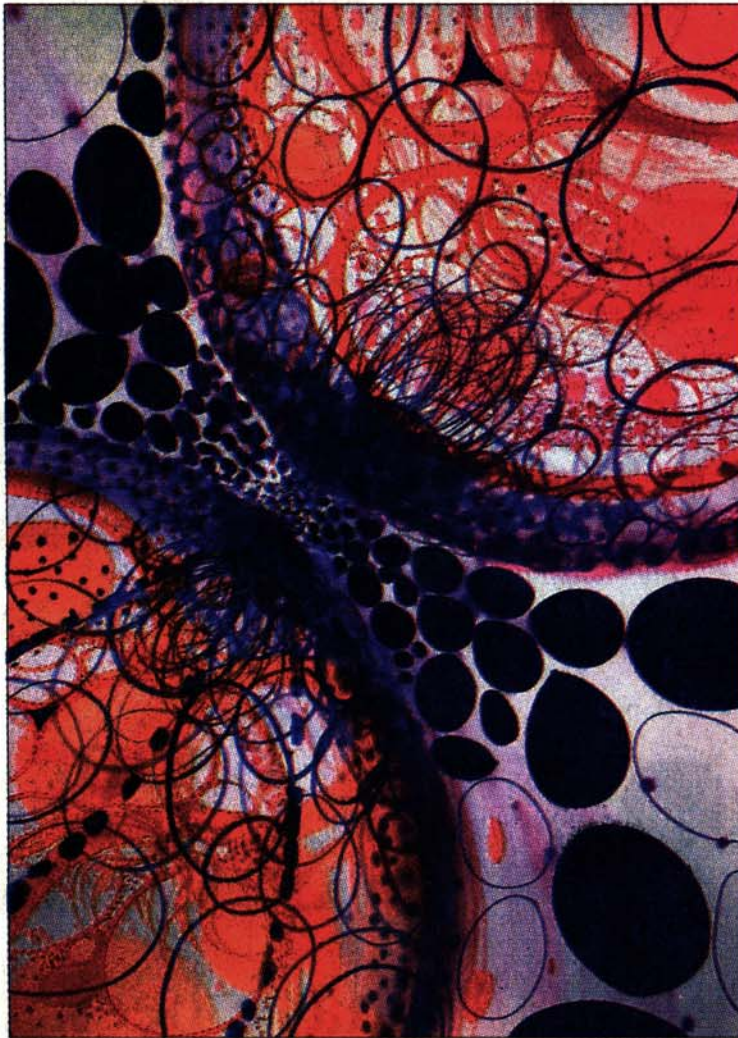

Works by Lee at Black Rock

Works on paper by **Eva Lee** of Ridgefield will be part of the exhibit "Current Abstraction" exhibit opening on April 29 and running thru June 3 in the The Black Rock Art Center.

The show features the work of six mid-career artists who have been dealing with abstraction and the issues of color, form, and texture.

Ms. Lee's works on paper "suggest other universes, although her work process begins with a just a few marks on paper which inspire her to create her other worlds," said Margaret Roleke of Redding, who is curating the show.

"These six artists demonstrate new approaches to abstraction through installation, drawing, paintings and sculpture," Ms. Roleke added. "All six artists have shown in prestigious galleries and museums throughout the country."
